

## The Combined Power of Saskatchewan's Learner's Licence Prep Kit and PowerPoint Presentation

The Prep Kit PowerPoint is an instructional tool designed to be utilized with the Learner's Licence Prep Kit. The PowerPoint contains the Prep Kit cards: The question is presented on one slide, followed by its answer on the subsequent slide. Instructors can review the cards with their class as each student works through their own cards. At The Passing Zone, we highly recommend that every student has their own Prep Kit to ensure that they have the opportunity to master the concepts.

The Prep Kits and the PowerPoint, when used together, are a powerful, flexible and effective learning strategy because:

- 1) There are many different types of learners. As instructors review the PowerPoint, students can address their own learning styles by custom-tailoring their cards, when needed, to enhance their understanding of the main concepts.
- 2) Most students will require a more prolonged practise period and will progress through the cards at different speeds. They also have the opportunity to study with a friend or in study groups outside of the classroom.
- 3) Parents can monitor their teenagers' progress and know if they are ready to take the Learner's Knowledge test. Our rule of thumb to parents is that if you go through the cards with your child and every card is **not** in the "I know it pile" then they are not yet ready.
- 4) English Language Learners can add information or translations to the cards to ensure that they understand the concepts and the vocabulary. Although we have provided definitions for many words, individuals who are learning English may require additional explanations.

The PowerPoint is copywritten and is intended for singular use. It will be licensed to one instructor and/or computer only. Bulk pricing will be available for loading on multiple computers and/or locations.



The **Learner's Licence Prep Kit PowerPoint Presentation** is a powerful teaching tool when used in conjunction with Learner's Licence Prep Kits. To best enhance student learning:

1. Review the Prep Kit flashcards section by section with students, discussing each slide. Students can add or clarify information on their own cards.
2. Engage students in active learning through group activities as suggested in the *Prep Kit User Guide*.
3. Encourage individual practice and study time. Students should practise the cards on their own, dividing the cards into "I know it" and "I don't know it" piles. This could be done in class, or assigned as homework.
